Tarabut is an Open Banking startup serving the nascent MENA banking region.

At Tarabut, I line-managed 3 stream-aligned teams with a peak of 14 direct reports. Under my support, these teams delivered a number of "tentpole" features, including Transaction Persistence, Transaction Categorisation, Arabic Translation, Product Whitelabelling, and Salary Identification.

My time at Tarabut was also a period of organisational transformation, with a number of teams spinning up, or being reshuffled. The opportunity of this as an Engineering Manager is in creating the mentoring conditions for team members to take on new responsibilities and further their careers. I also had the pleasure of crafting a hiring process for Tarabut, which was then used to make key strategic hires in an otherwise challenging economic environment.

> In my time at ComplyAdvantage, I, orchestrated delivery of Payment Screening, Multi-Factor Authentication, a "KYC for Business" feature ("KYB"), and an extended "CJK" transliteration project for ComplyAdvantage's Screening backend.

My time at ComplyAdvantage was also a period of significant organisational growth, in which I played a pivotal role. I built the hiring process, then conducted over 160 interviews throughout 2021. For my effort, I directly hired 18 candidates into my teams over that year, and sat on the hiring panel for many more. At peak, I directly managed 18 individuals across 4 teams, including managing other managers.

I also dealt with many broader Engineering organisational challenges, including building Growth Pathways, dealing with performance issues in teams, and addressing employee retention challenges.

SilverRail is a rail API services company majority-owned by Expedia Group.

At SilverRail I operated as the Engineering Lead for the Account-Based Ticketing team ("ABT", think "Oyster for rail"). This involved hiring and managing a team of 6 engineers, and directing development of mobile apps on both iOS and Android. I also single-handedly designed, architected, and built the ABT backend services, which included complex algorithmic work on "best fare finding", and integration with payment services for ticket purchasing.

The project culminated in a live trial on Chiltern Railways, with mobile apps available for both iOS and Android, and ticket-gate hardware integration.

Lyst is a fashion-technology startup aiming to bring the insights of ML and big data to the world of fashion.
